

Stafettlogg – what is it?

Stafettlogg [relay log] is a **digital coordination tool** that gives you a better overview when several services are cooperating to help you/your child.

Why use *Stafettlogg*?

This log can make the work between the home and kindergarten/school easier and it can help when you need to cooperate with several case workers/agencies. The log gives you a clear overview of the challenges you are to work on together to find a solution and which measures you have agreed upon. Each measure has a case worker that is responsible for it and a deadline for evaluation.

How does *Stafettlogg* work?

The log is established when you have given your **consent** and want to have a *Stafettlogg*. The family/person in question owns the log and decides who can have access to it. To be granted access to *Stafettlogg* one has to log in via the internet. Everyone who has access logs in by using their own Bank-ID.

The log is put together in coordination meetings with you and the relevant services. The case worker who has the most regular contact and has the tightest follow-up of the child / pupil / youth in the services has the role of “**baton holder**”. This is your regular contact person and the person who coordinates the cooperation and writes in the *Stafettlogg*. This person will use the log to invite you to coordination meetings and to document what you have agreed on in the meetings. You can log into the *Stafettlogg* at any time to see what has been agreed.
